Foundation Certificate in Fundamentals of Logistics (FCFL)

About the Course

Shipping and logistics are dynamic and evolving areas that need to be continuously understood. The disciplines associated with logistics continue to transform the competitive landscape and has become one of the key business drivers. Both the academic and business worlds accept the need to adopt a complete view of shipping and logistics, and consequently, interest in the professional study of shipping and logistics have grown in all private and public sector organizations.

This course is designed to give an overview of the basics of shipping and logistics, covering an array of topics ranging from the basics of shipping and logistics operations to concepts such as safety, customer service and documentation. Successfully completing this course would act as a foundation to anyone aspiring to broaden and/or transform career opportunities, and pave the way for further learning into the logistics industry.

Registration

• Students need to fill an online application form and submit to IITE

Examination

The student will be assessed based on the online assessments given at the end of each module. The student needs to score a total of 50% from each module in order to secure a pass. Each examination consists of 10 multiple choice questions (MCQ). The students need to complete the MCQ within the given timeframe.

If a student fails to secure 50% in the first attempt, a re-examination will be offered freely to the student. If the student is unsuccessful in securing 50% in the second attempt, the student is required to re-register for the unsuccessful module and successfully complete the exam prior to the next module.

Certificate Awarding

- A digital certificate will be awarded for the participants.
- A 'Certificate of Completion' will be awarded to those who successfully complete all 16 modules.
- A 'Certificate of Participation' will be awarded to those who do not successfully complete all 16 modules.
- The certificate will be awarded by the Island Institute of Tertiary Education IITE
- The certificate endorsed by Maldives Association of Freight Forwarders (MAFF); Advantis Campus, Centurion Transport Solutions (CTS), Maldives; and Maldives State Shipping (MSS)
